Radio Personality "Shotgun Tom" Kelly to be PPB's Next President

In May, **"SHOTGUN TOM" KELLY** was voted unanimously by the board of directors to be PPB's next president. Tom has been entertaining southern California radio and TV audiences for over

entertaining southern California radio and TV audiences for over 45 years. He's worked at such renowned radio stations as KGB-AM (in its Boss Radio days) and gained national acclaim at the legendary KCBQ. In 1997, after a nationwide talent search, "Shotgun Tom" was chosen by CBS radio's K-EARTH 101 Los Angeles to fill the coveted afternoon drive slot after the death of The Real **DON STEELE**. "Shotgun Tom" is also heard around the country doing voice work and commercials, and can currently be heard on commercials, and can currently be heard on SiriusXM's "60s on 6" in the afternoon.



In 2000, Tom won Radio and Records "Oldies Air Personality of the Year." Previously, he was honored at B-100 radio (KFMB-FM) with the Billboard Magazine Air Personality of the Year Award for Major Markets, and in the 70s he received two Emmys for hosting the children's TV game show Words-a-Poppin'.

In 2013, "Shotgun Tom" received his star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, located at the corner of Hollywood Blvd. and La Brea Ave.

Tom will take over the helm of PPB on August 1st. We thank outgoing President ALAN PERRIS for his three years of dedicated service to our organization.

PPB's Diamond Circle Award Presented to Jeff Wald

PPB past President CHUCK STREET presented the organization's Diamond Circle Award to JEFF WALD on March 16.

Jeff worked as a TV news director, executive producer, news consultant, and educator and is best known as news director of KTLA, Channel 5. He was born and raised in L.A. and started at KTTV as a messenger and production assistant. He moved to KTLA with GEORGE PUTNAM



and produced *Talkback*, and then went to KNXT, Channel 2, as assignment editor. One day, he learned that the LAPD had a house surrounded with members of the Symbionese Liberation Army, the kidnappers of newspa-per heiress **PATTY HEARST**, inside. He positioned a crew across the street and viewers watched the LIVE gun battle between the SLA and the LAPD. After KNXT, Jeff worked for **FRANK MAGID** as a news consultant and two years later, in 1981 returned to L.A. as news director of KTLA at the age of 29.

He was then recruited by KCOP-TV to compete directly with KTLA and expand their news operation. He then started his own TV news consulting firm. Jeff returned to KTLA in 1997 and served as news director for 10 more years.

Jeff's won 13 Emmys, 23 Golden Mike Awards, and was named Journalist of the Year by the Greater L.A. Chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists. Currently, he is VP of marketing for Lights! Action! Company - a motion picture lighting firm with his wife, GABRIELLE and his father-in-law, HANK WEISS, a PPB member for over 30-years.






